

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER
HAYWARDS LANE & STATION ROAD, CHILD OKEFORD

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991. The Order is required to enable Wessex Water to replace the water main. The order will come into effect on Monday 16 July 2018 and will remain in force for 18 months. However, the works are anticipated to start on Wednesday 18 July 2018 and be complete by Sunday 30 September 2018.

This order will be in three parts:

Part one will close Hayward Lane between its junction with Southfield Lane and the school, and this will commence on Wednesday 18 July 2018. The second part, which will follow on after part one is complete, will close Station Road, between Homefield and Duck Street / High Street. The third part will be a temporary parking restriction (approximately 25 metres) on Hayward Lane, immediately north of its junction with Allen Close, to create a passing bay to aid traffic movements along that part of Hayward Lane. This will be in place for the duration of the works.

Alternative vehicular routes for diverted traffic will be signed using Hayward Lane, Station Road, Duck Street, the A350 through Stourpaine, the A357 (Blandford Road) through Durweston and Bere Marsh, and vice versa.
